KNOW THE HOTSPOTS: Okanogan County has highest incidence rate in state, says county public health

The Okanogan County Public Health issued a release over social media stating the county has the highest incidence rate for COVID-19 in the state with a total incidence rate of 917 between July 9-22.

Douglas County had the second highest incidence rate, 638, over that time period. Ferry County had an incidence rate of only 55.

The incidence rate measures of the number of cases over a 14 day time period and divides that by the 100,000 population to show the spread of the virus.

In total, Washington Department of Health is reporting the following cases:

- Okanogan - 755 cases, 2 deaths
- Ferry County - 18 cases
- Stevens County - 89 cases, 1 death
- Spokane County - 3,863 cases, 60 deaths
- Lincoln County - 13 cases
- Grant County - 1,276 cases, 13 deaths
- Douglas County - 808 cases, 7 deaths
- Chelan County - 1,133 cases, 10 deaths
- Yakima County - 10,017 cases, 204 deaths

CDC: Masks are a critical tool in fight against COVID-19
