The Colville Reservation remains closed through Dec. 31

The closure of the Colville Reservation to non-essential visitors continues to midnight on Dec. 31.

Through Sep. 30, additional COVID-19 restrictions remain in place. These include the prohibition of public gatherings or camping in groups of ten or more people, the stay at home order for residents of the Colville Reservation, and the prohibition on non-essential business activity on the Colville Reservation.

Fines will be imposed for violations of these restrictions.

Stay healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The CDC states, "Staying healthy during the pandemic is important. Talk to your healthcare provider about whether your vaccinations and other preventive services are up to date to help prevent you from becoming ill with other diseases.
