Colville Reservation remains closed to non-essential visitors, per tribal resolution

The Colville Business Council extended the partial shutdown of the tribal government and additional public safety orders through midnight, September 30.

These public safety orders include:

- prohibition of public gatherings or camping in groups of 10 or more people,
- a stay at home order for residents of the Colville Reservation
- prohibition on non-essential business activity on the reservation

All outdoor recreational activities such as camping, fishing, hunting, and hiking are permitted only for tribal members and their immediate families who are all residents of the Colville Reservation.

The closure of the Colville Reservation to non-essential visitors continues to midnight on December 31, 2020 as previously ordered.

Fines will be imposed for violations of these restrictions.

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing • Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
