COVID-19: If results are pending, please wait for clinic's call

NESPELEM - The Colville Tribal Emergency Operations Center would like to ask patients who are waiting for pending results to please refrain from calling the clinics. The clinics will call patients individually when results are available. Please do not call and overwhelm the clinic's phone lines.

Currently, the Colville Service Unit clinics in Nespelem and Omak have multiple tests pending results from outside labs.

Nationally, outside test labs are taking 8 to 10 days to return results. Your patience on this is appreciated.

Patients on the Colville Reservation sign an agreement regarding legislation passed by the Colville Business Council that requires the patient to stay in quarantine while their results are pending and to stay isolated, until released by a medical professional, if tests return as positive.

The Colville Service Unit and Lake Roosevelt Community Health Center Clinics of the Colville Confederated Tribes continue to offer COVID-19 Random Testing. This means if a patient of any of our clinics would like to have a test they can come to any of our 4 clinics.

Below is the schedule of hours for the testing; of course if a person is symptomatic or has been exposed or suspect they have been exposed it is very important for them to be tested.
