Positive 16 Death 1 Released from isolation 14

EOC confirms 1 new case of COVID-19 in Omak District

OMAK - The Colville Tribal Emergency Operations Center has confirmed through Okanogan Public Health a new positive case of COVID-19 in the Omak district.

According tribal health officials, the individual remains in isolation.

The threat of COVID-19 remains very real in our community. Please continue to follow social distancing measures.

- Stay home, stay safe.
- Practice social distancing by keeping a distance of about six feet from others if you must go out in public.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after being in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home if you are sick, except to get medical care.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing or sneezing; throw used tissues in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily.
 This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, handles, desks, computers, phones, keyboards, sinks, toilets, faucets and countertops.
- If surfaces are dirty, clean them use detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection.

If you think you have come in contact with someone who has COVID-19, stay home and self-monitor for at least 72 hours. If your symptoms worsen, contact your health provider.
