The Colville Tribal Emergency Operations Center continues to work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 across the Colville Reservation.

The EOC is working to provide local clinics and businesses with personal protective equipment and other resources to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 amongst other actions.

The EOC is also working with the tribal Area Agency on Aging to assist elders with meals, chores and other services.

We know COVID-19 is in our communities and it is now as important as ever to follow social distancing guidelines.

Washington Department of Health is reporting 17,951 positive cases and 992 deaths across the state.

Counties around the Colville Reservation are reporting:

Okanogan: 35 cases, 1 death (including reservation totals)

Ferry: 1 case, no deaths

Stevens: 9 cases, 1 death

Lincoln: 2 cases, no deaths

Grant: 185 cases, 3 deaths

Douglas: 124 cases, 3 death

Spokane: 393 cases, 30 deaths

Chelan: 170 cases, 6 deaths

Stay home, stay safe. Practice social distancing by keeping a distance of about six feet from others if you have to go out for essential business. If you have to go out, wear a mask. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds

If you have symptoms of COVID-19, if you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who is presumed positive, the EOC encourages you to contact your medical provider.
