MTFC announces open burning for preapproved burn barrels, recreational pits May 20-25

The Mount Tolman Fire Center announced open burning for pre-approved burn barrels and recreational fire pits on the Colville Reservation between May 20 and 12 p.m. on May 25 and further ask that additional precautions and guidelines are followed.

Recreational fires still need to be in pre-approved fire pits, and the release notes if you have acquired a recreational fire permit in the last three years then that permit is valid for the same pit.

Additional guidelines:

- Construct a fireline at least 4 feet wide to mineral earth
- Have at least one person in attendance while burning
- Have a full bucket of water or a charged hose available
- Fire may not contain rubber products, plastics, asphalt, garbage, dead animals, petroleum products, paints, pesticides or any similar materials that may emit dense smoke or create offensive odors when burned. No hazardous materials of any time may be burned.
- Do not burn if wind is more than 5 MPH.
