### Colville Tribal EOC wishes all to have a safe Memorial Day Weekend

The Colville Tribal Emergency Operations Center asks those celebrating the unofficial kickoff to summer to continue to maintain social distancing and follow proper safety measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 on the Colville Reservation.

Here are a few things to know as we enter our long weekend: The Colville Tribes remains closed to visitors, and the Colville Business Council has extended:

- the prohibition of public gatherings of ten or more people
- the prohibition of camping by non-tribal members or groups of ten or more people
- the closure of fishing and hunting by non-tribal members within the boundaries of the reservation.
- the requirement of residents to remain home except for essential activities
- closure of the Colville Reservation to visitors

Mount Tolman Fire Center announced opening burning is limited to previously approved burn barrels and recreational fire pits from May 20 to 12 p.m. on May 25.

Celebrate the holiday and enjoy summer safely:

1. Keep social distance and avoid congregating.
2. Consider activities or spaces where social distance comes naturally.
3. Assemble a COVID-19 kit for the road.
4. If you or someone in your home feels sick, stay home.
5. Know where to local emergency health services.
