CBC extension through May 29 includes prohibition on gatherings of 10 or more people

Included in the extended closure of the Colville Indian Reservation, which was passed Friday by the Colville Business Council, is the prohibition of gatherings of 10 or more people within the reservation boundaries.

With Mother's Day upcoming this weekend, please continue to practice social distancing to protect our families and especially our elders.

To date, 10 of 11 cases on the reservation have recovered and have been released from isolation. While our numbers remain low, the risk of exposure still exists in our communities.

The emergency resolution also:

- extends the prohibition of public gatherings of ten or more people
- extends the prohibition of camping by non-tribal members or groups of ten or more people
- extends the closure of fishing and hunting by non-tribal members within the boundaries of the reservation.
- extends the requirement of residents to remain home except for essential activities
- extends closure of the Colville Reservation to visitors.
