### **EOC ask those who attended rallies to consider being tested Thursday or Friday**

NESPELEM - The Colville Tribal Emergency Operations Center asks all community members who were in attendance at recent rallies in Spokane and elsewhere to self-isolate and get tested Thursday or Friday for COVID-19. We also would ask this of anyone who has traveled outside of the region, especially by air, or to high impact areas.

Patients of the Colville Service Unit can be tested at Nespelem drive through or Omak clinic curb side.

Patients of Lake Roosevelt Community Health Center clinics can call 509-722-7006 to schedule a testing time.

Though we have been able to keep our numbers low to date, the risk of COVID-19 remains very real in our communities. Even if exposed, a person may not test positive until several days after being exposed to COVID-19. Furthermore, symptoms can take up to 14 days to show.

The CDC reports symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- cough
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- fever
- chills
- muscle pain
- sore throat
- new loss of taste or smell

Children have similar symptoms to adults and general have mild illness. This list is not all inclusive. Other less common symptoms have been reported, including gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.
