Colville Tribal EOC asks community members to maintain social distancing, safety protocols

The Colville Tribal Emergency Operations Center is asking all community members to maintain social distancing and other safety protocols to guard against COVID-19.

Many of the counties surrounding the Colville Reservation have seen an increase in COVID-19 cases recently.

While the Colville Reservation remains closed to non-essential visitors, with the upcoming holiday vacation, we anticipate more people and more chances of coming into contact with COVID-19 in the communities around the reservation.

Current county totals:

- Okanogan - 116 cases, 2 deaths
- Ferry - 1 case
- Stevens - 18 cases, 1 death
- Lincoln - 4 cases
- Grant - 621 cases, 5 deaths
- Douglas - 245 cases, 3 deaths
- Chelan - 348 cases, 7 deaths
- Spokane - 1,420 cases, 41 deaths
- Yakima - 7,476, 159 deaths

Use these simple steps to keep yourself safe:

- Wash your hands often
- Wear a mask in public
- Avoid close contact with others
- Clean and disinfect often
- Monitor your health daily and be alert for symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath and other symptoms.
- Take your temperature.

The CDC says the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus. The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person with people who are in close contact with one another (within 6 feet).
