Indian Health Service reports 1,416 cases of COVID-19 in Washington, Oregon and Idaho

The Indian Health Service is currently reporting 1,416 cases of COVID-19 in the Portland region, which includes Washington, Oregon and Idaho.

On the Colville Reservation there have 51 new cases of COVID-19 on the Colville Reservation and a total of 79 cases.

The Seattle Times reported, July 23, the Yakama Nation has had 683 cases of COVID-19, 100 of which have been since July 3.

Yesterday Washington Gov. Jay Inslee reported, "A month ago, Yakima had one of the highest COVID-19 rates in the country. Today, they have bent the curve and are one of the few counties in WA heading in the right direction.

What changed?

They went from 65% to 95% of people wearing masks."

Know the symptoms of COVID-19

The CDC has reported people with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms, ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue

- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

This list does not include all possible symptoms. CDC has stated they will continue to update this list as we learn more about COVID-19.
